RESEARCH METHOD: Content Analysis

The focus of this study was to determine the overall coverage worldwide of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The newspaper articles that were recorded for this study were found through the LexisNexis database during January 1- April 16, 2016. Student researchers followed strict coding guidelines to identify what newspaper articles were appropriate, using a codebook of common key terms and focusing on English language media.
